Re: Introduction to Counselling Skills

Thank you for enquiring about our next Introduction to Counselling. This is a four-week non-accredited course beginning **Wednesday 8th January 2020 from 6pm-10pm** at JMC Counselling Unit 23, CDDA, 51 Dungannon Rd BT71 4HP. Certificates of attendance will be presented on completion of your training.

This training will give students insight into the world of counselling skills and theory, as well as addressing the need to enhance personal confidence and communication skills. The training will also address progression should students wish to proceed, to the accredited ABC accredited Level 3 Award in Counselling Skills and Theory, which is a 70-hour training programme beginning immediately after the Introduction.

Should students wish to further their studies following the Certificate, they can apply to enrol on the accredited level 4, ABC Awards Diploma in Therapeutic Counselling, which is a professional counselling qualification and forms part of the necessary requirements to become a professional counselling practitioner.

All training will be provided by highly trained counselling practitioners and Tutors.

Should you wish to simply register for the Introduction, or continue with your studies thereafter, we would be delighted to hear from you.

Fees for this training are set at a reduced rate of £95.00 for the Introduction to Counselling Skills. This course is usually £195.00. Unfortunately, as JMC Counselling & Training are an Independent Counselling Centre, we cannot provide facilities for either reduced rates or funding.
